## IMPORTANT UPDATE FOR RESIDENTS

I have enclosed an invite to our Sundowner with Minister Troy Buswell who will provide an update on all road infrastructure currently under construction, many of which are on Gngangara Rd. I hope to see you there.

The Liberal State Government is committed to the total upgrade of Gngangara Rd as well as lights for Reid Hwy and Lord St.

With our Government's commitment to the Perth-Darwin Hwy at a cost of \$900M, there is no doubt that this area will be a big winner from this major project. A District Plan can be found on the reverse of this letter for your information.

It has been predicted the area opening up for development for commercial purposes north of Ellenbrook as a result of the Perth-Darwin Hwy may be several times the size of Malaga and capable of creating some 16, 000 employment opportunities. Development to this extent will create an economic future for this area and strengthen the viability of local business.

In this term we have built new Primary Schools in Aveley and Malvern Springs, complete with airconditioning which we had to campaign for. The Ellenbrook Secondary College has been extended to year 11 & 12 at a cost of \$25M. Another Secondary School at North Ellenbrook will open in 2015 and cater for future district growth. Our new Ellenbrook bus service has been extended to Aveley with consideration for an extension into The Vines in the future.

The State Governments by-passing of the Ellenbrook restrictive covenant which is in force until December 2018 has allowed for a huge expansion of our shops and services, we have also built a new fire station and facilitated a permanent St John's Ambulance presence in Ellenbrook.

Finally there has been some misunderstanding regarding the new Electorate boundaries of Swan Hills and West Swan. Aveley and The Vines will remain in the Swan Hills Electorate and I look forward to working with you for this area's future.

Over the next few weeks I will be doorknocking your street and I am happy to discuss any suggestions and ideas that affect you and your family.
