**Important information regarding your Residential Net Feed-in Tariff subsidy**

Dear

On 19 May, 2011 the Western Australian State Government announced changes to the Residential Net Feed-in Tariff scheme, with a new rate of 20 cents per kilowatt hour (c/kWh) to be introduced from 1 July, 2011 and a scheme installed capacity limit of 150MW.

As an existing Residential Net Feed-in Tariff customer, Synergy is pleased to advise that your subsidy rate of 40c/kWh will not change and you will continue to receive 40c/kWh for the net export of electricity for the full term of your 10 year contract.

However, to accommodate the State Government's changes to the Residential Net Feed-in Tariff subsidy the Renewable Energy Buyback Scheme Terms and Conditions were recently changed.
