We will continue our support of small businesses by reducing red tape.



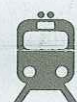

We live in a great State. Western Australia is experiencing a once in a generation period of transformation. We have record levels of investment, low unemployment rates and one of the highest standards of living in the world.

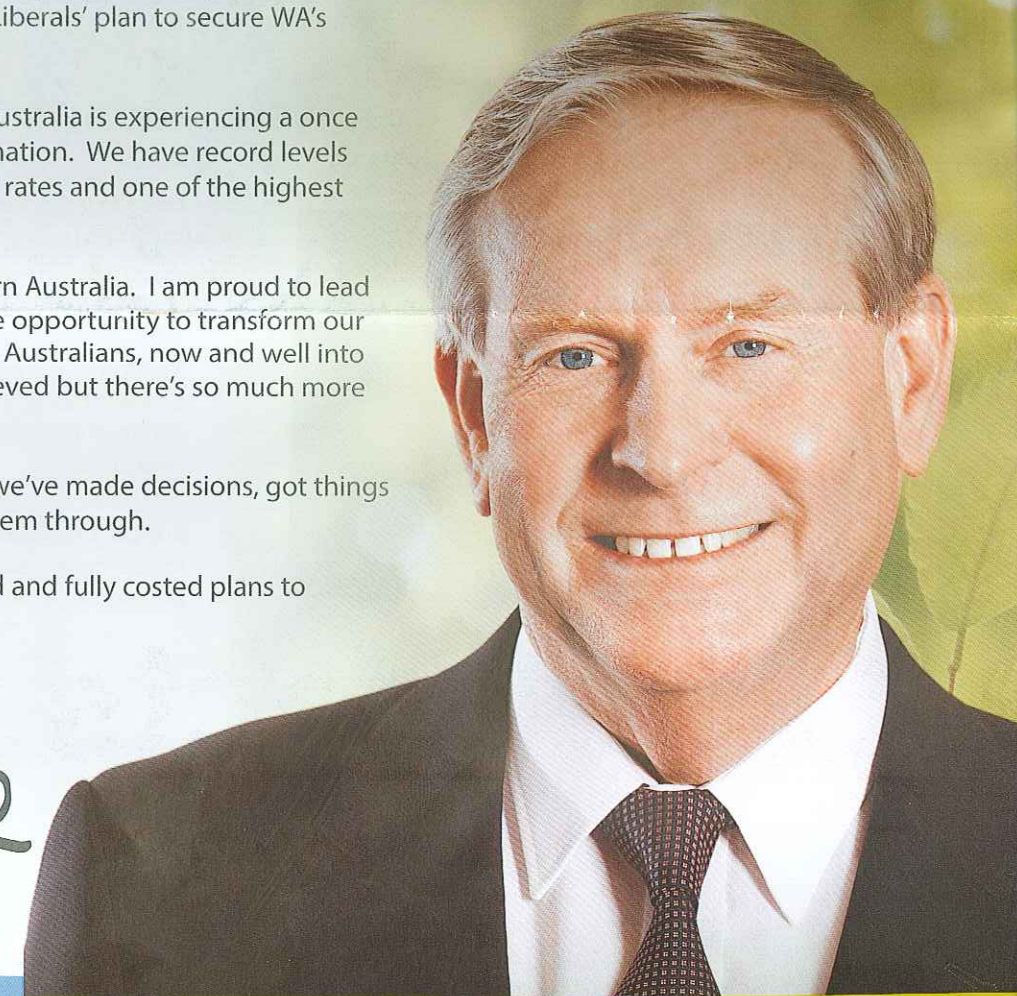

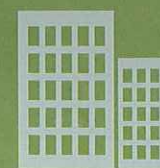

# Our Plan for Western Australia



## We will: Make your community safer



The Liberals will make the decisions needed to make our communities safer. A Liberal Government will:

- Put more police on the beat with an additional \$282million to recruit an additional 550 police officers, establish a new rapid response unit and upgrade suburban police stations
- Send repeat burglars to jail and introduce minimum mandatory sentences of at least seven and a half years for criminals who seriously physically and sexually assault residents in their own homes
- Put more CCTV cameras on our streets to deter crime and ensure centralised access to deliver rapid response policing

- Target hooners in suburban areas with new measures allowing for permanent confiscation of hoon vehicles and unlicensed trail bikes as early as their first offence, as well as increased resources for police to crack down on this menace
- Introduce GPS tracking for serial arsonists and serious domestic violence offenders
- Provide more support for victims of crime, including those who have been subject to domestic violence.

## We will: Stand up for WA's fair share



The Liberals will continue to fight to ensure Western Australians get a fair deal from the Federal Government.

A Liberal Government will:

- Fight for a fair share of GST revenues, no less than 75 cents of every dollar we contribute
- Continue to stand up against Labor's mining tax
- Never agree to cede control of public hospitals to the Federal Government
- Continue to support and negotiate with the Commonwealth on a national disability insurance scheme, subject to an assurance that no-one is left worse off, services are managed at a State level and the excellent work of the not-for-profit organisations is not undermined
- Fight Federal intervention that would jeopardise the success of the State's Independent Public Schools program
- Demand the Commonwealth recommit to its obligations to put the future of native title and the benefits it provides for Indigenous Western Australians beyond question.

## We will: Broaden the State economy



The Liberals have a vision to broaden the Western Australian economy and build on our natural advantages.

A Liberal Government will:

- Make science a priority in our economic and social development, including with a world class museum and learning opportunities for children at a relocated new Scitech
- Support scientific and research programs in WA, including increasing funding for medical research and development of our minerals technology industry

- Invest \$24million over four years for tourism marketing, to attract interstate, local and international visitors alike to our iconic natural sights and world class events
- Continue support for the Oakajee Port and Rail Project in the Mid West Region to open up the State's next major mining province
- Support Western Australian agriculture, aquaculture and viticulture through practical measures such as the Ord River expansion, reduced regulation, and integrated programs such as promotional activities for our quality produce.

## We will: Maintain our nation-leading infrastructure program



Western Australia will continue to benefit from unprecedented infrastructure development under a Liberal Government.

A Liberal Government will:

- Build an airport rail link, including stations at the international and domestic terminals and in Forrestfield, for WA commuters and visitors alike
- Undertake a \$500m road program to upgrade and extend roads in the northern suburbs, including the Mitchell Freeway, Reid Highway and Malaga Drive
- Deliver the transformational 22km MAX light rail system to connect the CBD to North Perth, Mount Lawley, Dianella, Morley, Mirrabooka, Nedlands and Victoria Park by 2018
- Build a world-class, 60,000 seat stadium at Burswood in time for the opening of the 2018 AFL season.

## We will: Improve access to quality front line education and health services



An unprecedented investment is being made in ensuring quality health and education services for all Western Australians.

A Liberal Government will:

- Build six new Child and Parent centres, taking to 16 the number of centres to be established at public primary school sites
- Support more Western Australian public schools to become part of the successful Independent Public Schools initiative
- Reform the State's senior secondary education system and support all Western Australian students to meet minimum literacy and numeracy standards

- Appoint 155 new school health nurses as part of a \$57million boost to child health care, guaranteeing all children access to an early entry health assessment
- Deliver a new \$1.27billion children's hospital; a \$360million public hospital in Midland and open Fiona Stanley Public Hospital, as part of the largest hospital construction program in the State's history
- Provide \$22million towards construction of a new Eastern Suburbs University Campus to cater for up to 600 students.

A Liberal Government will:

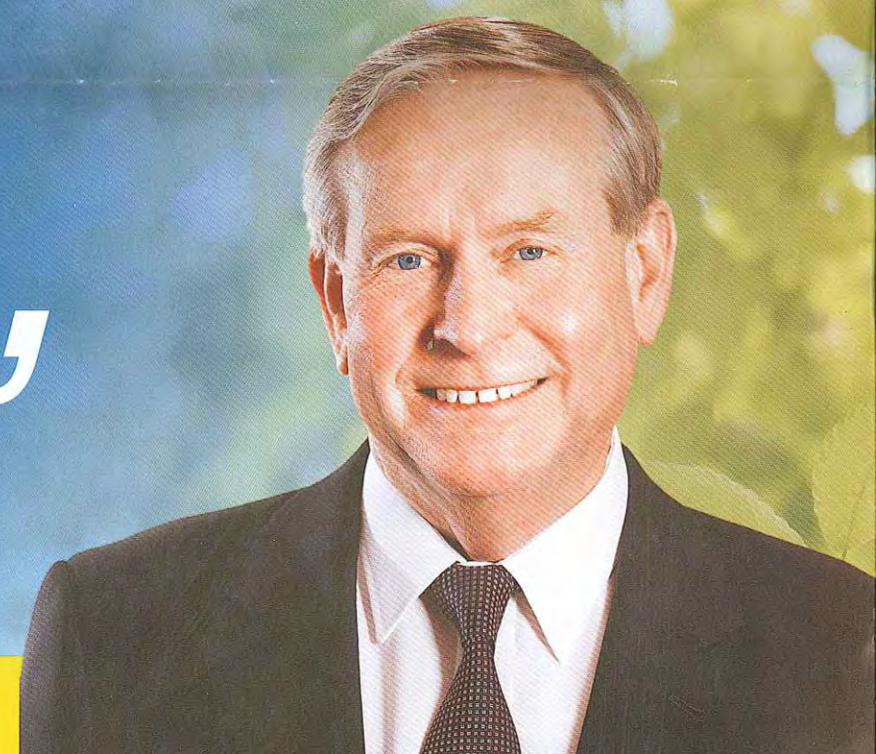
